OCTOBER PROGRAM: OUR ANNUAL PHOTO CONTEST:

The photo contest will have two categories: 1) Prototype railroads and 2) Model railroads.

Rules:

1. Photographs should be in the form of color or black and white prints, 4X6 inches or larger.
2. Each photograph should feature a railroad subject and be taken by the individual submitting the photograph.
3. Each photograph should have a description of the prototype/model railroad featured.
4. Enter up to 3 photographs per category.

Judging:

1. The club members present at the meeting will conduct the judging.
2. All entries should be given to the Contest Administrator prior to the start of the meeting. The Contest Administrator will number the photographs and display them for the club. The club will be able to view all photographs.
3. The club will vote for the photographs that best depict the category.
4. The photograph receiving the highest score will win.
5. First, Second and Third place awards will be given out in each category.

Being out of touch, I do not have anything else to add. See you at the October meeting.

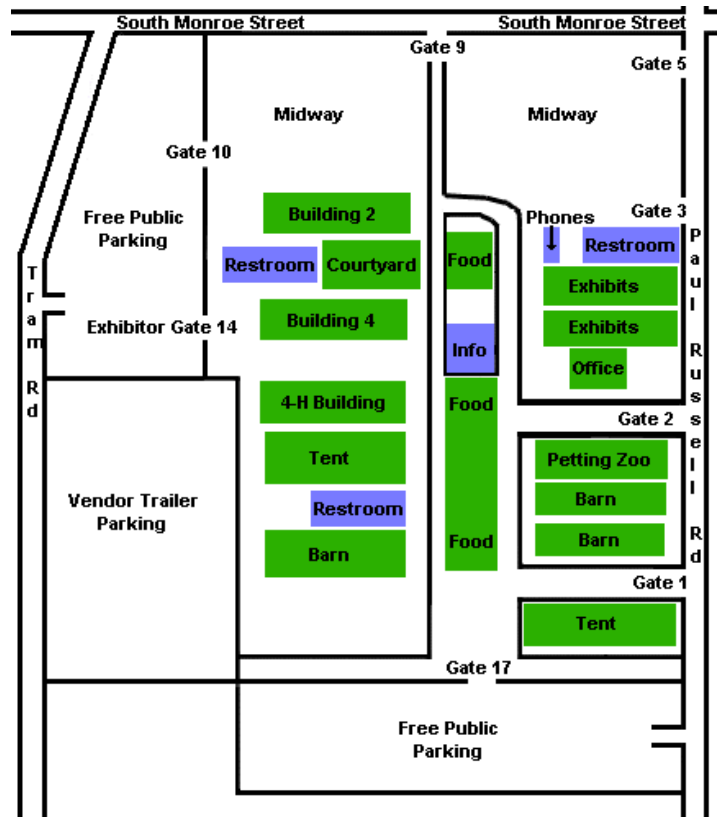
BBMRA Gearing up for North Florida Fair- submitted by

Sam Miller: We will set up the layouts on Sunday, October 27th. Operations will begin on Thursday, October 31st, and run through Sunday, November 10th. Tentatively, we will set up from noon to 5 p.m. on the 27th. I will be asking club members to come to the fairgrounds in shifts the following Monday through Wednesday and complete our selected projects. Breakdown is scheduled for Monday, November 11, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Hours of operation are 4:45 to 10:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, 4:45 to 11 p.m. on Friday, 11:45 a.m. to 11 p.m. on Saturday and 11:45 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Sunday.

The N Scale Division will operate their refurbished layout at the North Florida Fair this year as well, so the HO division will have to staff its layout without assistance, but I don't believe we will have any problems. We had plenty of help last year and it was a lot of fun.

Like last year, we will seek volunteers in two-hour shifts and encourage you to sign up for a double shift when possible. Two club members are needed per shift. I am asking Vernon Parramore to once again help me coordinate the scheduling and call club members and remind them of their assigned shifts. We will circulate the signup sheets at the October 15th BBMRA meeting for finalization.

 3. Questions were brought up about the fair layouts. BBMRA is contracted to have a working HO layout for 10 days. The N-Scale Div said they will have a layout ready to bring. The other question is for the Large Scale Div on their layout? I know improvements have been made. Are you planning on having the O-27 layout at the fair? Concerns have been made about being able to schedule 2 people each shift for all the layouts. Sign up with a friend or sign up with someone you don't know very well and get to know them. This may be a good time for the HO'ers to run a different scale. Get in touch with Vernon Parramore to add yourself to the schedule.
 4. Photo contest Rules. We decided to drop the part about what type camera, lens, settings when taking the pictures. Photos should be black/ white or color 4x6 or larger, have been taken in the year 2002, framing is not necessary and be of a railroad subject and be taken by the individual submitting the photo. A description of the picture is needed: example ' A CSX diesel building a container train in Baldwin, FL'.
- Categories: Prototype and Model. Enter up to 3 photographs per category. You may enhance the photographs as long as you are using your own pictures. Camera accessories like color filters are ok too. Look out for Larry's train in the snow pictures, they are great.
5. Those at the meeting decided that a 2-day show may not be a good idea right now. The decision was based on vendor comments and added expenses. This will probably be addressed again sometime later.
 6. More about the details of the fair will be discussed at the October meeting. Keep it on the rails!
