Thanks to David Brazell for submitting photos from the tour to the Lantern.

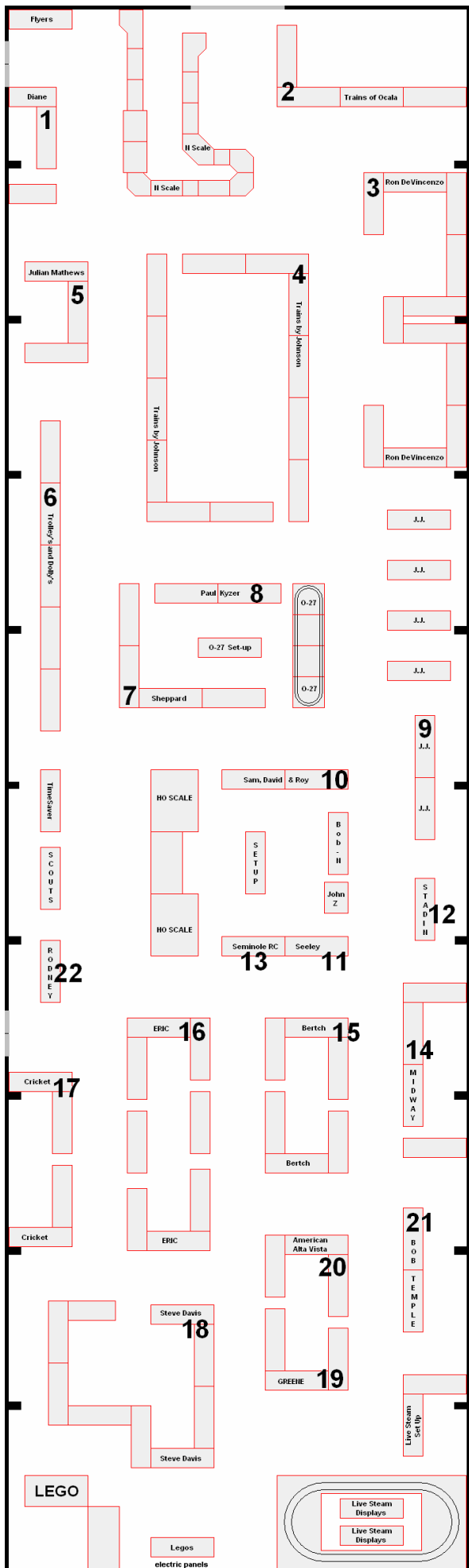
