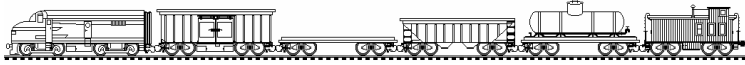

BBMRA History

The Big Bend Model Railroad Club (BBMRC) held its first meeting on September 15, 1987. The BBMRC was organized for the purpose of promoting and preserving model railroad activities for the benefit of the general public and the members of the Club and for the purpose of promoting and preserving historical material and information pertaining to railroad transportation. The Big Bend Model Railroad Club decided to incorporate and was chartered as "The Big Bend Model Railroad Association, Inc." (BBMRA) on June 28, 1990. The organization's unofficial motto is: "Run Trains!"

At present, the BBMRA is comprised of three divisions, the HO modeling division, the N-Scale modeling division and a Large Scale modeling division.

The HO Division maintains and operates a modular layout that measures 8 by 24 feet and the N Division maintains and operates a modular layout that measures 10 by 40 feet.

Meetings are usually held on the third Tuesday of each month. Clinics and other member-oriented activities are conducted during the meetings. Member swap meets are held semi-annually and a photo contest is held annually.

During the summer, the Association sponsors our Tallahassee Model Railroad Show & Sale at the North Florida Fairgrounds. This event showcases our Association and its members.

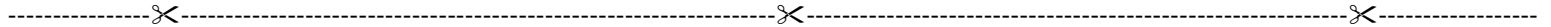
The BBMRA's fiscal year runs from the 1st of January through the 31st of December.

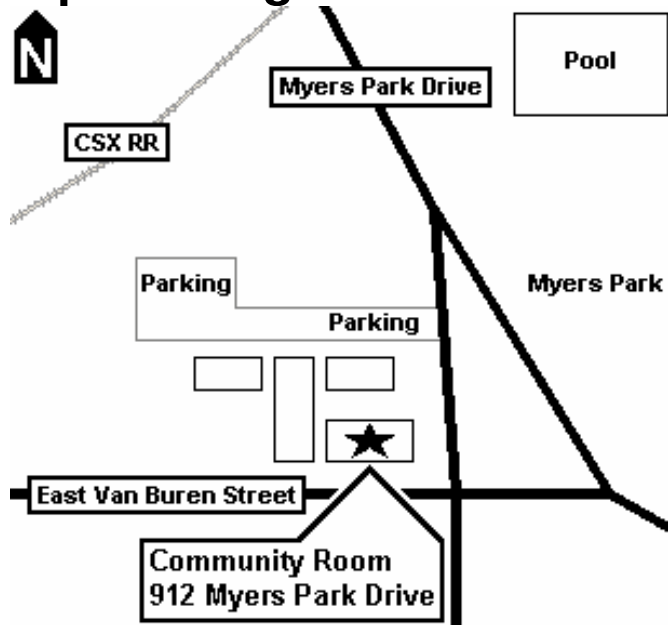

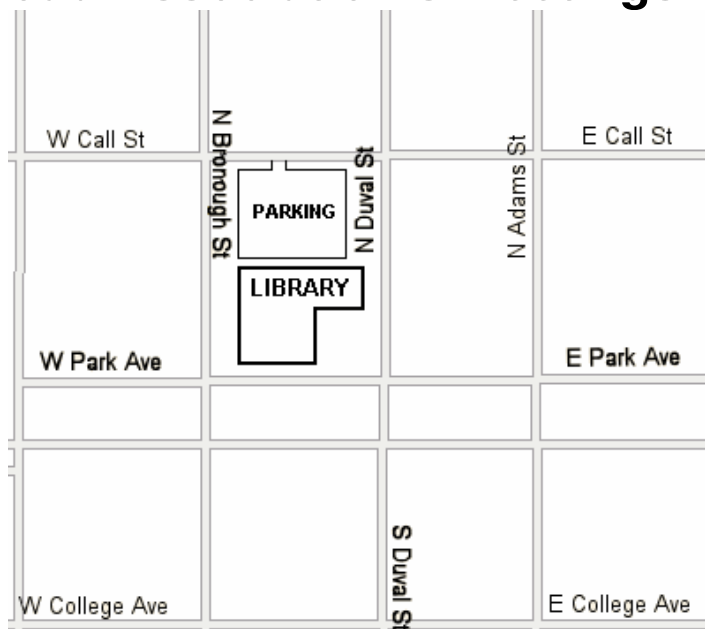


City of Tallahassee's Parks and Recreation
